

General Election 2024 Vote for Peace and real Security

Women in Black is an international network of women for peace with justice and against war, militarism and violence. For us, peace is not the mere absence of war. Real security means being able to live without fear from all forms of violence. For women, security means equality and independence, food and shelter, health and education. Women are the first victims of war, but we hold the key to peace

The UK's investment in war and a culture and economy of militarism creates untold human suffering and degrades the planet. We believe that there are concrete steps that can be taken to build real peace. The General Election offers an opportunity for citizens to raise critical questions with candidates about how this can be achieved.

Suggested questions for candidates

Our role in current wars and climate crisis. Would you advocate and support an immediate ceasefire in Gaza & Israel? How might you enhance the role of women peacemakers and diplomats through Foreign Office conflict prevention projects in Ukraine, Sudan, DRC and beyond? Refugees and asylum seekers: Would you be prepared to support an end to the detention of immigrants – an inhumane system which causes great distress? Would you support measures to allow asylum seekers to work and so feel part of society and earn much needed income?

Nuclear Weapons and Arms Trade: Will you urge the UK government to fulfil its obligations on nuclear disarmament by signing the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons?
