

£205 billion for Trident?? NHS not Nukes Save Lives & Build Peace

Human Security V Nuclear Insecurity - Tell Labour To Choose Peace & Health

Nuclear weapons are a massive problem for global security. They don't prevent wars or give anyone safety or security. They are called 'deterrents' but deterrence often fails, as the Russia-Ukraine and Israel-Gaza genocide tragically demonstrate. Nuclear weapons didn't prevent the Ukraine war, but they do increase the risks of nuclear war – whether by miscalculation, misguided politicians or military mistakes. The existence and possession of nuclear weapons like the UK's Trident put the whole of humanity at risk.

The UK has an opportunity now to change history for the better. Instead of wasting over £7billion a year of our taxes on continuing to make British warheads and submarines to carry US Trident missiles around the world, the Labour government could cancel Trident and join the new multilateral UN treaty that bans nuclear weapons and creates the legal obligations, practical steps and verification systems to abolish all nuclear arsenals and enhance security for everyone. This UN agreement is called the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW), and it already has the support of more than 130 UN governments who are determined to prevent the horrors of nuclear war.

Joining this important Treaty and disarming Trident would set an important example to the world – and other nuclear-armed countries. At a time when Chancellor Rachel Reeves is looking for where cuts can be made to restore and improve health, care and education services, scrapping Trident would free much needed resources for the NHS and tackling other real and urgent security threats such as climate destruction and violence against women and girls. Committing to nuclear disarmament and verification will also create new jobs.

Nuclear weapons costs keep rising beyond the hefty £205 billion envisaged in 2006. For what? The so-called 'nuclear deterrent' doesn't deter and it cannot be fired without destroying Britain along with most of the world.
